



INTRODUCING SPAY ALABAMA

SPAY ALABAMA is a program whose goal is to end the euthanasia of healthy and treatable dogs and cats in Alabama. The program was set into motion by Lynne Fridley of Maddie's Fund, and Esther Mechler, Found of SPAY USA. The program will **provide a single center, a single phone call, that accesses all sorts of useful information regarding the various spay/neuter delivery systems, clinics and programs statewide.** This means that even people in the poorest, most isolated parts of the state can, with a single (free) phone call find out where their nearest affordable spay/neuter program is, and how to get help. We can also identify areas of no service and help get programs started in those areas. A single toll free number will eliminate confusion and runaround. Toll free numbers afford accessibility to everyone, even those without computers. Other developments including high volume spay/neuter clinics in Birmingham and Montgomery, and a spay/neuter car tag program are coming soon.

We ask everyone to join us in supporting this effort to end the national epidemic of euthanasia of healthy and treatable dogs and cats.
